We tried to compete with the weather, as it was raining a lot in between! - So ladies and gentlemen, here it is:

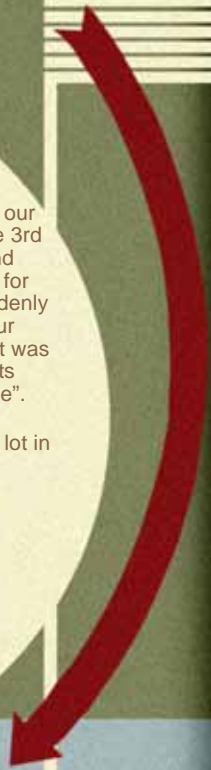

recorded in 1947 for Capitol records in Los Angeles!
Note the early Be Bop - influence in this tune, always
nice and naughty!

10 years back in time there even was a spring, even in
the deepest clubs down in Harlem! Willie The Lion
Smith recorded his

2. ECHOES OF SPRING

in the mid 30's. Have an ear on the rolling piano parts
of the Lion's left hand: furious!

a prolific classical tune!

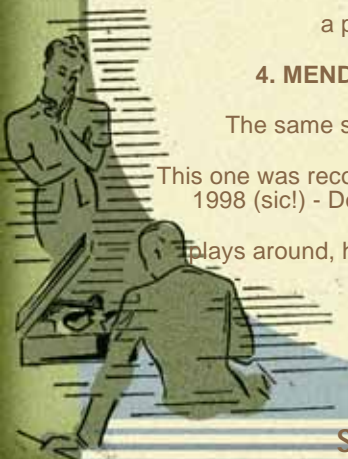
4. MENDELSSONS SWING SONG

5. SINGIN' IN THE RAIN

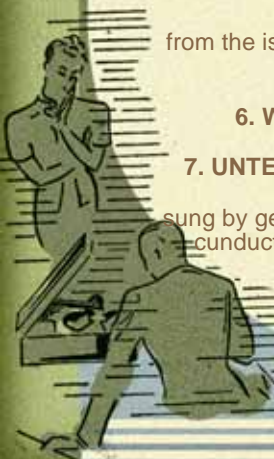
You know Ray Gelato and his Giants? - They come from the isle and they know the rain especially well, given by nature! From the 90's
